

Getting Around



- Please note that the meetings will be held in the FHWien Campus (Address: Währinger Gürtel 97, 1180 Wien, Austria).
- A private bus will drive us from the FH Wien Campus to the restaurant

Transportation to and from the airport

The City Airport Train:

- Connects the airport with the transport hub at Wien Mitte non-stop in only 16 minutes.
- Passengers can check in at the City Air Terminal Wien Mitte daily from 5.00 am to 9.00 pm for selected Star Alliance flights (Austrian Airlines Group, Lufthansa etc.) from 24 hours up to 75 minutes before departure; check-in on the evening before from 6.00 pm to 9.00 pm.
- The exact check-in times can be found either by contacting customer services of the individual airlines or at <u>www.cityairporttrain.com</u>
- Price: Single: €11, return: €19; Tickets can be purchased at <u>www.cityairporttrain.com</u>, from ticket machines and from Tourist Info at the airport

Railjet:

- There are 2 connections per hour to the airport from Vienna Meidling Station and Vienna Main Station. These run every 25/35 minutes daily from about 7 am to 10.00 pm.
- Travel time: 15 minutes
- Ticket price: €4.10 (€1.70 for the outer zone + €2.40 for the Vienna city zone)
- Tickets can be purchased at <u>www.oebb.at</u>, at the ÖBB ticket counter at the airport, from ticket machines and via the <u>ÖBB Ticket App</u>

Express train S7

- The express train plies between Vienna Airport and Floridsdorf. The journey takes 37 minutes.
- The timetables can be found on the ÖBB website: <u>www.oebb.at</u>
- Tickets: As the airport is located outside the Vienna city zone, you will need two single tickets: one for the zone up to the Vienna city limits for €1.70 (outer zone) and a ticket for the Vienna city zone for €2.40.
- Tickets can be purchased at <u>www.wienerlinien.at</u>, from ticket machines and from tourist information at the airport

Bus connections

- The buses of Vienna Airport Lines take you direct to Vienna city center, to the Donauzentrum via Vienna International Centre (VIC), or to the Westbahnhof and Vienna Main Station. The Blaguss Air-Liner offers non-stop connections to Erdberg.
