Do's and Don'ts Graduation Competition

DO'S



Establish a strong connection between the objectives & results.

Point out the key research issues, your methodology & novelty of your findings.

Start from a clear hypothesis and demonstrate it through results & conclusions.

Start & end your paper with a broad angle on an issue that many readers can connect with.

Use paragraphs wisely and integrate audiovisual materials.

Integrate a literature review & use citations where necessary.

DON'TS



Don't write a series of summaries or make it an opinion piece.

Don't describe what your research was about.

Don't make any statements without proof.

Don't waste too much space on research and methodology, go for a balanced trichotomy of the two + the novelty.

Make sure the poster helps the jury understand the abstract, but do not repeat the same information.
